## **Important Information**

- 1) This is a one-time grant in the amount of \$1,000.00 which may be applied for annually. It is to be used in pursuing a degree in education such as certification, advanced certification, or adding a field of endorsement. This grant is available to any certified or classified employee who works in a Georgia school system grades PreK- 12).
- 2) The GRE Foundation application **must be postmarked** on or before the second Friday in April, **(April 12<sup>th</sup>).** There is no need to expedite your application.
- 3) All scholarship recipients will be notified by the third Friday in June, June 21st. A check will be mailed to the recipient as soon as a note of acknowledgement, (by way of email), is received. This note will be used by the GRE Foundation as verification. Be sure to provide an email address where you may be reached during the month of June.
- 4) Information, including the name and picture of winners, will be published in the GREA BULLETIN. You may download a copy from <a href="https://www.georgiaretirededucators.org">www.georgiaretirededucators.org</a> website.
- 5) All application information is to be mailed in one package to the address above. This includes **the application** printed on the front side only; **a picture, suitable for reprint,** no larger than a 5x7 with your name and email address printed on back; and a **sealed envelope** containing a letter of recommendation from your principal or an immediate supervisor not related to you. Since this is a busy time of the year for staff and supervisors, it might be helpful for you to request this letter early.
- 6) The GRE Foundation screening committee will judge all applications.
- 7) **Please note:** neither picture nor application will be returned. This information will become the sole property of the GRE Foundation. Feel free to keep a copy of this application.
